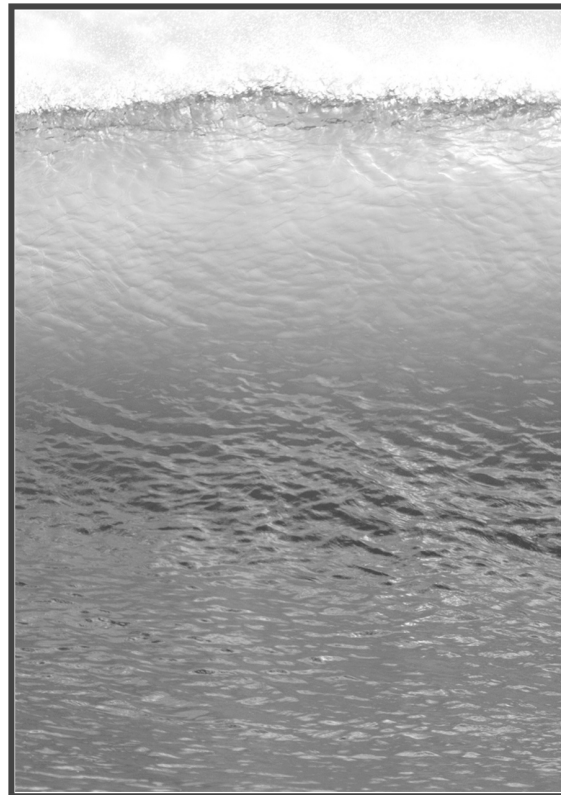

3-Tone Rule

Light	
Medium	
Dark	

TIP #1: Practice the “3-Tone Rule” by choosing 3 tones (light, medium & dark) for each color you are using. For example, if you are using blue then make sure to have a light, medium and dark blue. Do this for each color you are using.



TIP #2: Pay attention to light areas of the grayscale page and leave the light areas without any colors or, if you are using the Burnishing Technique (flattening the surface of the paper with heavy pressure on the tip of the pencil) then burnish the lightest areas with white.

TIP #3: Waves are translucent and they reflect the colors behind them. Tie your background colors into your main subject.
